SUMMER CAMP FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What weeks will summer camp be offered at the Club?

Summer camp will last for 9 weeks. You must register for each week in which you'd like to participate. Camp begins the week of June 29th (no camp on 7/4) and ends the week of August 24th. Note that space is very limited for Week 9 of summer camp due to our camp counselors returning to their college campuses.

What are the hours of the camp day?

Camp is offered 9:00 a.m. through 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Extended early morning care is available from 7:30 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. for an additional fee of \$25 per week.

How much is camp tuition?

Ages 5 & 6: \$230 per week Ages 7 - 11: \$210 per week Ages 12 - 14: \$155 per week

Does the Club offer financial assistance?

- **Limited** financial aid is available for those families who qualify. Applications are due April 17, 2020. Decisions will be postmarked on or before May 1, 2020. Those applying are still required to complete the full application and pay the registration fee and deposit.
- The Club also accepts childcare vouchers. **Proof of an active voucher must be provided at the time of registration.**
- The Club also offers a 12 week payment plan for any family that may wish to extend the payments of their balance to make it more manageable. Please ask for a payment form at the time of registration. Your credit or debit card will be charged once per week, May 25th through August 10th.

How do I register?

- Please note that we will NOT accept any summer camp registrations without a completed physician's form from your child's doctor that includes an immunization record.
- March 2, 2020 March 26, 2020. Families of youth & teens who are ACTIVE members of the Club's programs (Clubhouse, ATB, BTB, Project Learn, L.E.A.P.) between 9/1/20 and 2/28/20 or who participated in summer camp in 2019. Parents may register at the Clubhouse Front Desk during normal business hours.
 Note that the Clubhouse is closed March 9 March 13. Those not signed up by 9:00 p.m. on March 26th will have to attend public registration day.
- Early registration does not guarantee enrollment. Camp will fill and slots are given away on a first come, first serve basis. Please do not wait to register if you intend to enroll your child for summer camp.
- March 28, 2020: Public Registration Day will be open to non-members seeking to enroll their child(ren). Space is limited and will be awarded based on a lottery drawing. Lottery tickets will be given out beginning at 9:00 a.m. and numbers will begin to be called at 9:15 a.m. Lottery tickets will NOT be given out after 11:00 a.m.
- Beginning March 30, 2020, families may register for any slots that may remain. Registrations can be submitted at our Clubhouse Front Desk during regular business hours.
