

AFTERSCHOOL FAQS

Q: Is there a limit to the amount of days a week I can sign up for?

A: No, but only sign up for days you plan to send your child. Space is limited and we hope to serve as many members as possible. Repeated absences will result in removal from the session and/or restrictions in signing up for future sessions.

Q: Do I have to sign my child up 4 times this year?

A: Yes & No. We have 4 afterschool sessions this year and you will need to enroll your child in each session. You only need to complete the membership form and pay the \$25 dues once a school year.

Q: What COVID safety measures are you implementing at the Club? A: The Club is continuing to practice limited capacity, 3 feet spacing, masking, frequent handwashing and contact tracing. Masks are required for all who enter the Club. Mask breaks will occur during snack time and upon request to a staff.

Q: What do I do if my child turns 8 years old in the middle of a session? A: Membership at the Club starts the 1st day of your child's birth month the year they turn 8! If this happens in the middle of a session, you can sign up for that session but your child cannot attend until the 1st day of their birth month.

Q: Will you be open on half days and when there is no school?

A: The Club follows the Woburn Public Schools calendar for closures including inclement weather. The program will be offered on WPS half days, beginning at dismissal. Please note that the Club is not childcare and other scheduled closures may occur. All changes will be communicated to families in a timely manner.

Q: What does it mean when you say "this program is not childcare?"

A: Your child will always be supervised by Club staff throughout the day but members will need to be able to make choices and take responsibility in what they engage in while at the Club. This includes making sure their homework gets done and making positive choices in program options.

Q: What kind of choices will my child have at the Club?

A: Members will have two program choices during each day at the Club. Choices will be in the areas such as social recreation, arts and STEM and occur after daily homework help.
